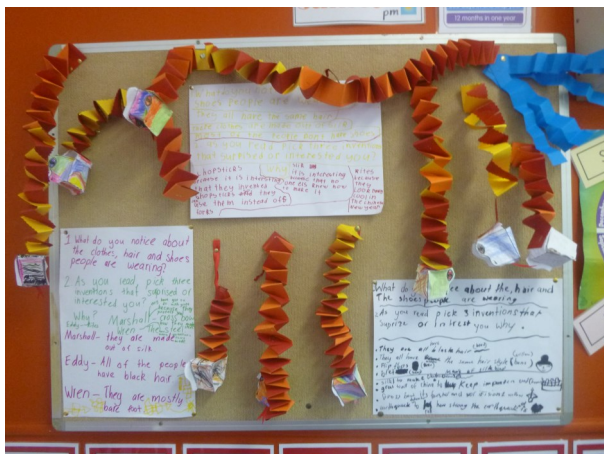
NAPLAN
