Marshall—completing homework takes in maths and reading from Ms Landers.

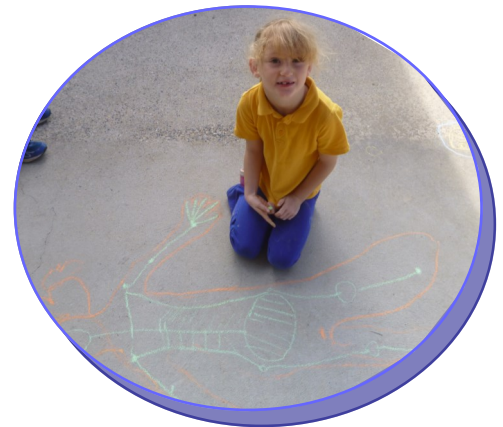
Georgianna—for working on her maths cards—and with perfect results from Ms Landers.
