In the event of a student needing
an ambulance the protocol is as
follows:

Staff attempt to contact parents
or care givers, if there is no
immediate response, then
nominated emergency contact.
A staff member will travel with
the student to Macksville
Hospital.

In the case of the school needing
to be evacuated our evacuation
point outside the school area is
the pub at Taylors Arm. This is
the recommendation of the
Rural Fire Service and is in their
evacuation plan for Medlow
School.

For those new to our
community, there is a
defibrillator located at the Pub.
