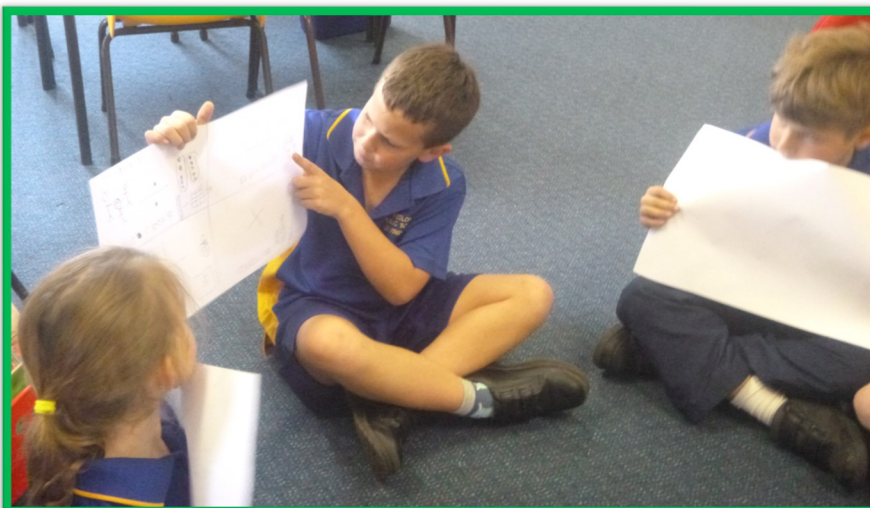
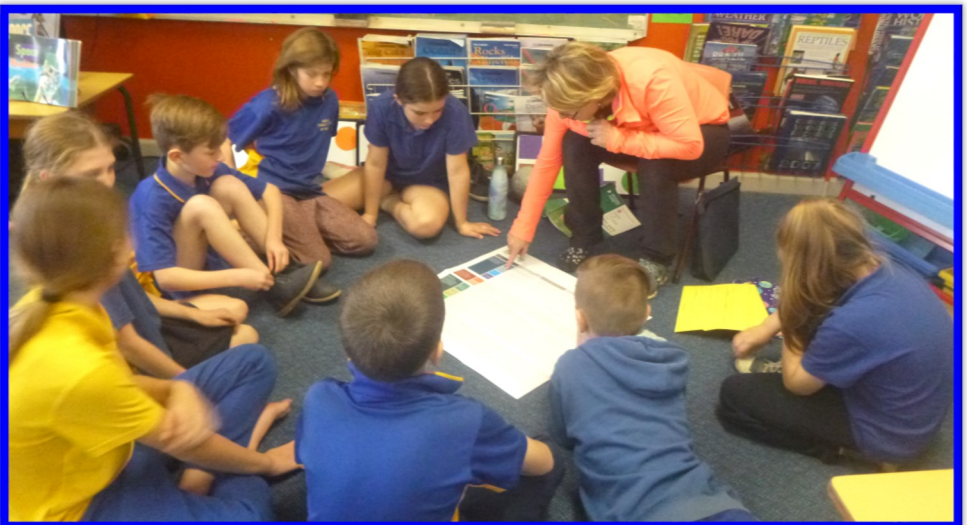
Senior students discussed the following questions in their Personal Development class.
